


TRICK OR TREAT SAFETY TIPS

Leaves changing color is not the only indicator of the Fall season, another is the annual observance of Halloween in the form of children wearing costumes and trick-or-treating. If your children plan on doing this this October, please share the following safety tips below with them (http://www.hauntedwisconsin.com/trick_or_treat_safety.html):

- Always walk, do not run.
- Stay on sidewalks. If there is not a sidewalk, walk in single file on the left side of the road facing traffic.
- Carry a bright flashlight to illuminate sidewalks, steps and paths.
- Obey traffic signals.
- Because one car stops, it doesn't mean others will!
- Don't cut across yards or driveways.
- Wear clothing with reflective markings or tape.
- Make sure your costumes don't drag on the ground.
- Visit homes that have lights on esp. ones with Halloween decorations.
- Accept treats only in the doorway. Never go inside a home.
- Stay away from animals you don't know.
- Always be polite.

Included is information on the only approved style and type of roofing shingle for the subdivision (gray "Weathered Wood" fiberglass composition shingle with a weight of no less than 240 lbs. per square).

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Lakeline Oaks General Homeowners Association & Board Meeting September 2007

The **September 6, 2007 general HOA meeting** was attended by only a handful of homeowners with Carl Gamble from Goodwin Management present. Residents brought up the following two concerns:

- High school overcrowding. This was addressed at the LISD Workshop Meeting held on June 7, 2007. More details can be found by clicking on "Board Meeting Agendas" in the Board Meeting section under Community Involvement of the Leander ISD website (www.leanderisd.org). Also, please check the website for more news and developments in our school district. Right now, they are seeking parents/community members for the 2007 Fall Attendance Zone Advisory Committee.
- Neighbors that leave their garage door(s) open unattended. The issue was the liability of the homeowners if anyone, especially children, entered their garages and got their hands on items that could endanger themselves.

In addition, the BOD stressed that the following deed restrictions will be enforced: **overnight parking, vehicles parked in the driveway in such a way as to block the sidewalk for pedestrians especially for children since school has started, and the number of vehicles in the driveway being the same as the number of garage spaces.**

Following the general HOA meeting, the board of directors (BOD) held their own meeting. Carl Gamble went over the planned 2008 budget and reported that after all expenses the HOA would have a \$109.00 surplus. In addition, he stated that a HOA our size should have a \$65-75K cash reserve. Right now, the HOA has only \$35K. Therefore, the question was posed if annual dues should be raised, but no decision was made. It was, then, mentioned that dues payment coupons would go to printing after November 11th.

Carl Gamble asked as to when to start formal collection proceedings, which is the next legal step when late fees do not resolve delinquency. The BOD unanimously voted on one year. A lending agent for a home equity loan asked the Board to agree to a subordinate agreement. In the unfortunate event of a foreclosure, this agreement would place the home equity loan lenders' interests in front of those of the HOA's. The BOD voted against signing subordinate agreements (Robert Kenny—No, Dr. Don Carr—No, Steve Davies—Yes). Lastly, subcommittee meetings to allow residents to participate in previously published ACC topics were scheduled (see page 3).

Municipal Utility District (MUD) News

The utility district, WTCMUD#1, will be holding an election in May. Two director positions, which are four-year terms, will be up for appointment. If interested or want more information, please contact Steve Davies at 512-336-8213.

 Landscaping: Greater Texas Landscape Services, Inc., who handles the landscaping maintenance of the common areas of our subdivision, addressed the decline of the begonias at the main entrance on Lakeline Oaks Drive. They have been working to resolve this with fertilizer and proper trimming. The increased summer heat after the prolonged rains we received earlier in the season stressed many of the plants due to developing shallow roots. In addition, they have adjusted the irrigation schedule to help relieve some of this stress and will continue to monitor them. We pointed out that no begonias were planted at the signs that flank both ends of Little Elm Trail. They were inadvertently missed, so Wizard Coleus were installed in place of them.

The fall change out is expected to occur in late October. Majestic Giant Pansies will be planted in the color combination of purple and yellow or purple, yellow, and white. We are currently going over the maintenance contract they presented for the upcoming 2008 year. Though there was no price increase, the company suggested additional services that we should consider. We will present them to the BOD if we find them beneficial.
